# 2010 Kodiak Island Deanery Report

---

2010 was an active year in the Kodiak Deanery.

Archimandrite Juvenaly continues to serve Port Lions which saw the formation of a parish council and an construction work that has seen the church insulated and remodeled during the past several months. Priest Alexei Knagin and laborers from St. Innocent Academy worked alongside the faithful in Port Lions to renew the church structure.

Priest Gregory Parker and his family continue their labors in Old Harbor. Along with his parish duties Father is also working in the community. Currently initiatives are being undertaken to renew the church structure and graveyard. An OCMC team came in July and was a part of the local family camp. It was a time of renewal for both the village and team!

Igumen Iosaph continues his labors in Akhiok. Currently he is building a small residence next to the church so that visiting priests will have a place to stay. He is also working in the community and at this time is residing in Akhiok year-round.

The village of Larson Bay is currently being served by Priest Joshua Resnick of St. Innocent Academy. An active working relationship between the Academy and deanery is helping to foster a more united front to our labors here on Kodiak Island.

Archpriest John Dunlop continues to serve as Dean of St. Herman Seminary and pastorally serve the village of Ouzinkie. Currently he is able to serve the village for major feastdays and when a pastoral need arises.

Priest Innocent Dresdow continues as Dean of Holy Resurrection Cathedral and serving the pastoral needs of those in Karluk. Holy Ascension was celebrated this year in Karluk in Alaska's oldest church structure. A team assessed the physical needs of the building and agreed that the roof must be repaired if the church is going to stand for much longer.

The deanery hosted the annual St. Herman Pilgrimage and attendees included Metropolitan JONAH, Archbishop JUSTINIAN (Moscow Patriarchate) Bishop BENJAMIN and Bishop MAXIM (Serbian Archdiocese) and many visiting clergy and faithful from around North America. Archbishop JUSTINIAN brought a delegation from Russia that included the vice-president of the Russian Duma.

In conjunction with the Archdeacon Kyrill and St. Herman Seminary, the deanery helped host a Diaconal Practicum that was attended by deacons and laymen from throughout Alaska and the lower 48. A field work day on Spruce Island was included in the schedule.
