

THE ALASKAN PENINSULA DEANERY
Report for the 2010 Assembly

The Alaska Peninsula has one resident priest, Father James Gust. The area needs at least one more resident priest, a missionary who would probably live at Naknek, serve the parish there and travel to Pilot Point, Port Heiden, Perryville, South Naknek and possibly Sand Point/King Cove. This assignment would probably not include any appreciable stipend, so the missionary or his spouse would need to work to support themselves, or we would need to raise a considerable fund elsewhere to support this work.

Father James can report the number of visits he has made to these communities, as well as the number of baptisms, chrismations, weddings and funerals he has served in the territory of this deanery during the last twelve months.
